*In place of HIST 274, you may use an e-permit to take LHis 301 (Th 6:15-9:35pm) at the School for Labor and Urban Studies. Note this is a HYBRID course.*

*In place of LABST 320 you may use an e-permit to take either LPOL 301 (F10-12pm); LHis 311 (W6:15-9:35pm); LABR 302 (T6:15-9:35pm) at the CUNY School for Labor and Urban Studies. Note these are HYBRID courses.*

**To Use EPERMIT to Sign up for a Class at SLU,:**

Go to your **Student Center** on Cuny1st

Under Academics, use drop down menu – find **epermit**

Select Add epermit – Fall 2021+

Permit Type = Major elective

Host College = School of Labor and Urban Studies

Host Session – Click Search, select REGULAR

Host Career - Click Search, select UNDERGRADUATE

Subject = Click Search, Select LHIST++

Course Number = Click Search, Select desired course number

!! Important – in the Comment section, make sure to put the QC course equivalent. I.e. HIST 274 = LHIST 301, 311; LABST 320 = LABR 330!!
